#### **POLICY STATEMENT**

School psychologist license applicants shall demonstrate, for admission to the oral examination for the license, a passing score on the Praxis-II School Psychologist Exam (#5402) reported directly to the Board by the Educational Testing Service (ETS). Applicants taking the current Praxis-II must achieve a score of 147. Applicants who took the exam between 2008 and 2014 must have achieved a passing score of 165. Test scores remain valid for ten (10) years after the testing date. Applicants with scores more than ten (10) years old are required to retake the current Praxis-II and earn a score of 147.
