Dr. Ross began by presenting the following quarterly reports:

- Budget Report—Expenditure and Revenue Detail FY21 Q4 & FY22 Q1

- Enforcement Report/Investigation Summary Data FY21 Q4 & FY22 Q1
- Licensing/Exam Detail FY21 Q4 & FY22 Q1

Next, Dr. Ross reviewed recent rule changes that went into effect 3/21/22. He also sought the Board's directive to file several corrections to citations that were missed when filing amendments to 4732-9-01:

4732-9-01 Requirements for admission to the examination for a psychologist license.

The requirements for admission to the examination for a psychologist license, which are generally set forth under division (B) of section 4732.10 of the Revised Code, include that the applicant be at least twenty-one years of age. In addition, he/she shall have received from an accredited (see paragraphs (E) and (F) of rule 4732-3-01 of the Administrative Code) educational institution an earned doctoral degree in psychology or school psychology. In addition, all applicants shall have had at least two years (thirty-six hundred hours total) of supervised professional experience in psychological work of a type satisfactory to the board. Applicants seeking admission to examination under division (B)(~~3~~)(2)(a) of section 4732.10 of the Revised Code shall provide evidence of an earned doctoral degree from a program holding accreditation or designation from an entity listed in divisions (B)(~~3~~)(2)(a)(i) to (B)(~~3~~)(2)(a)(iv) of section 4732.10 of the Revised Code, and one of the two years of supervised experience shall be a pre-doctoral internship. Applicants with a doctoral degree in a non-applied branch of psychology from a regionally accredited

institution who subsequently earn a certificate of specialty retraining from a clinical, counseling, or school psychology program holding program accreditation from the American psychological association, office of program consultation and accreditation, or the Canadian psychological association office of accreditation at the time the certificate is earned shall also be deemed in possession of a qualifying academic degree under this rule. For applicants seeking admission to examination under division (B)(3)(2)(b) or (B)(3)(2)(c) of section 4732.10 of the Revised Code, at least one year of the two years of supervised experience shall be post-doctoral. In addition, graduates of doctoral programs accredited by one of the entities listed in divisions (B)(3)(2)(a)(i) to (B)(3)(2)(a)(iv) of section 4732.10 of the Revised Code within two years of when the applicant was awarded the doctoral degree shall be considered graduates of an accredited or designated program. With regard to such requirements, the board hereby further prescribes that:

- (A) For persons seeking admission to examination under division (B)(3)(2)(b) or division (B)(3)(2)(c) of section 4732.10 of the Revised Code, the two years of supervised professional experience in psychological work of a type satisfactory to the board, at least one year of which shall be subsequent to attainment of the doctoral degree required by this rule, shall comply with all of the following requirements ~~if the training experience began on or after the effective date of this rule~~:

...(B) Persons making application for licensure as a psychologist under division (B)(3)(2)(a) of section 4732.10 of the Revised Code shall complete a minimum of two years (a total of thirty-six hundred hours) of supervised psychological experience of a type satisfactory to the board.

Dr. Jacobs made a motion to approve the rule amendments to OAC 4732-9-01 and to direct Dr. Ross to file them; Dr. Rabold second.

Dr. Ross then School Psychology Exam Policy 4.4—Reissue. This policy was rescinded at the October 2021 board meeting based on concern about statutory authority. Following that meeting, it was determined that Dr. Ross had not given adequate attention to an existing rule that references the Praxis-II school psychology exam requirement and clearly allows for a policy on a shelf-life for the validity of exam scores. Therefore, following consultations with Dr. Cole, it was recommended that the Board reissue the policy with one change to accommodate applicants who hold the Nationally Certified School Psychologist (NCSP) credential. Dr. Cole explained that holding the NCSP requires examination beyond the Praxis, and recognizing it is appropriate and supported by leadership at OSPA.

LAW AND RULE REFERENCES

Ohio Revised Code (ORC) 4732.11 Administering Examinations “(B)(1) Each applicant for a license to practice as a school psychologist licensed by the state board of psychology shall be required to earn a score acceptable to the board **on an examination selected by the board**. The applicant shall follow all necessary procedures and pay all necessary fees for the examination.”

Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 4732-11-01 Licensure examinations “(C) Pursuant to division (B)(1) of section 4732.11 of the Revised Code the board hereby prescribes that applicants for a school psychologist license **shall evidence a passing score on the nationally-administered credentialing test required by the Ohio department of education or the national school psychology certification board, whether it is the Praxis series school psychology test (Praxis) or a successor examination**...Candidates for the school psychologist license are not required to receive authorization from the board to be admitted to the nationally-administered credentialing test for school psychologist licensure.”

POLICY

School psychologist license applicants shall demonstrate, for admission to the oral examination, a passing score on the Praxis-II School Psychologist Exam (#5402) reported directly to the Board by the Educational Testing Service (ETS). Applicants taking the current Praxis-II must achieve a score of 147. Applicants who took the exam between 2008 and 2014 must have achieved a passing score of 165. Test scores remain valid for ten (10) years after the test administration date. Applicants with scores more than ten (10) years old are required to retake the current Praxis-II and earn a score of 147.

EXEMPTION-NATIONALLY CERTIFIED SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGISTS

Applicants holding the Nationally Certified School Psychologist (NCSP) credential are exempt from this examination requirement. The NCSP credential recognizes school psychologists who meet national standards for graduate preparation and continuing professional development. Board staff shall use the NCSP verification site at nasponline.org to determine if an applicant holds active NCSP status and qualifies for exemption from the Praxis-II score requirement.

Next, the Board heard a presentation by representatives of the **Ohio Physicians Health Program**, which offers a “Safe Passage” program the Board could implement in rule as its colleague assistance program. There were no policy actions in this regard, and the Board awaits additional material from the OPHP to assist in decision-making.

There was a 5-minute break.

Dr. Ross resumed his report by sharing information about ORC 2903.311 “Collin’s Law”—Hazing reports. A new state law requires reporting of hazing by school and university employees. There have been questions raised about whether this is a “mandatory report” for psychologists akin to reporting suspected abuse or neglect of a child, for example.

2903.311 | Reckless failure to immediately report knowledge of hazing.
Effective October 7, 2021

(A) As used in this section, "hazing" and "organization" have the same meanings as in section 2903.31 of the Revised Code.

(B) No administrator, employee, faculty member, teacher, consultant, alumnus, or volunteer of any organization, including any primary, secondary, or post-secondary school or any other public or private educational institution, who is acting in an official and professional capacity shall recklessly fail to immediately report the knowledge of hazing to a law enforcement agency in the county in which the victim of hazing resides or in which the hazing is occurring or has occurred.

(C) A violation of this section is a misdemeanor of the fourth degree, except that the violation is a misdemeanor of the first degree if the hazing causes serious physical harm.

Dr. Ross has been addressing inquiries from license holders by referring them to university or organization counsel and encouraging the use of the informed consent process to clarify limits of confidentiality if it is determined that otherwise privileged material is subject to disclosure under the law.

Dr. Ross next provided an overview of HB509 as passed by the House, which would amend the School Psychologist renewal and CE schedules in law. He and Dr. Cole have been working with the bill sponsors and other stakeholders to clarify the impact and encourage caution when reducing the CE requirements of license holders and impacting the Board’s revenue.

Next, following an update on the oral exam process, the Board agreed to form teams for the purpose of doing exams on a 6-8 week schedule to supplement the exams being conducted by Dr. Ross and Drs. Cole/Fields.

Finally, Dr. Ross ended his report with several announcements: An upcoming hearing in re: Fluhart will require the Board to deliberate on a hearing record prior to the October 2022 business meeting (unless the matter settles without a hearing); PSYPACT is now operating in thirty-one states; There is not enough funding available to pay for a Board representative to attend the ASPPB mid-year meeting; the APA masters program accreditation process is still in early stage and standards have been released for public comment; the Board's Biannual Auditor of State Financial Audit of FY21, FY22 began in early March and will be concluded by the end of December, 2022; and, license renewal will begin on the standard schedule of July 1, 2022.
